The New HF2.5WG has ¼" spacer and a Black Oxide coating. HF2.5WG fasteners can be used on virtually all grooved decking.

Tool and Fasteners are <u>Not</u> recommended for CorrectDeck. PT Decking, <u>Needs to be KDAT</u>, kiln dried after treatment.

- **HF2.5** are 2.5" long and have special points on each end to make them the most versatile fastener. HF2.5 has a 1/8" spacer, to help gap boards. Fasten decking 1" thick or less.
- **HF3** Is similar to HF2.5, but is 3" long. This fastener can be used on decking up to 1.5" thick.

HF3W - Is similar to HF3, but has a ¼" spacer, and has been blackened.

HF2.5WG -Is designed for grooved Ipe, and Composites, it has 1/4" spacer, and is blackened.

^{*} For an even easier installation, get boards grooved on one side, you can shoot a fastener through the square edge, and then slide the grooved edge under the second point.
